Auditors:

- We will be limiting the number of auditors. Anyone who would like to audit will need to register and send a deposit if you want to stay on the property.
- We will be locking the front gate so any daily auditors will have to text me to get the code to get in. *There will be no exceptions*. If someone doesn't pre-register (and this might be by phone or email prior to when coming, Because we will be following safety measure, anyone on the property will have to know what those are in advance and comply.

Masks:

- Everyone will be required to wear a mask. We will, of course, be practicing social distancing, but we feel that we should prepare for this measure as well. *Please bring your own and you should bring more than one so you can wash and sanitize them*. Now, we may be able to alter this masking but that will be determined by Harry and Mendin' Fences and you will be notified of the change.
- This is a very good article about <u>DIY masks</u>.
- And this is a good article about <u>disinfecting</u> them.

Meals:

- We will still provide meals, as usual, but we will be serving them, rather than having them "buffet" style.
- To increase the sanitary needs for this year, we are going to use plastic products.
- *Bring your own coffee and/or drinking vessel*. You will be responsible for cleaning it. You'll have to use the bathroom sinks outside or the sinks in the Bunkhouse.
- Meals will be eaten outside and using distancing requirements. Same for discussions.
- While the Pavilion will not be used for these things, the refrigerator and coffee/tea machines can still be used. There will be disinfecting wipes available and we expect everyone to take responsibility for using them.
- The Kitchen in the Cookshack will be absolutely off limits. Shelby and I need to preserve the food prep ... masks and gloves. (yippee)

Seating:

- Six feet apart. Everyone needs to participate in awareness and maintaining their own distance.
- It would not hurt to bring your own chair this year. The ones we usually have available will still be on-site.

Sleeping:

- A maximum of five (5) people will be permitted in the Bunkhouse. We will have it set up so that everyone sleeps on a bottom bunk with some coverings we will provide. Okay, sheets to make a canopy.
- We will have sheets and blankets and pillows but you may want to bring your own.

- The beds will all have those lovely crinkly mattress covers.
- Bunkhouse folks will need to work out a schedule for the shower and such and in a way that keeps everyone safe.
- The Bunkroom will have two people in it. Same deal as the Bunkroom.
- Remember, we do have that outside shower than can be used as well.

Each of you has been coming to Mendin' Fences for a long time and we have always appreciated your willingness to help with clinic and safety responsibilities. This year, we will need even more dedication to look out for ourselves and for each other. I'm sure there are other areas to be addressed but this is the core info you need in advance. And, of course, you can ask questions and/or add to this list.
